WATERWAY INVESTIGATION

GUIDELINES

- Zoom in on your investigation area using Google Maps – use both map and satellite views, clicking on various features to learn what they are.
- Label the features in the correct place on your paper/map.
- Research the features, including whether that feature is responsible for any processes that affect the local waterway, e.g. using chemicals/liquids that might end up in the waterway, releasing sewage into the waterway, litter bins near the waterway that might overflow, etc.
- Add fact boxes to the features, detailing any potential pollution risks and suggesting pollution solutions to keep the waterways healthy.
